

WRESTLE TITLE TO HOLY CROSS

Tigers Take Interscholastic Honors

The Holy Cross Tigers successfully defended their Louisiana interscholastic wrestling championship Saturday night at the Municipal Auditorium. The Bengals tallied 55 points while St. Aloysius placed second with 16. The Jesuit Blue Jays took third place with 11 while Fair Park of Shreveport and Isidore Newman tied for fourth place with three points each.

Warren Dugas of Holy Cross captured the heavyweight title for the second year in a row by dumping Harry Bonnet, a teammate, in the fast time of 13 seconds in the first period of their championship bout. Dugas entered the finals by virtue of his win over Charley Corne, also of the Bengal squad.
