# Green's 27 propels Wildcats past Bulldogs, 74-58

Green finished the game with 27 points, 12 rebounds and five blocked shots. Also featuring in the Mike Green Show were Vernon Lewis with 16, Nathan Scott with 11 and DeWayne Washington added 10. Alanzo Johnson led Lutchter with 18 points followed by Jeff Walthers and Kenny Jackson with 12 and 10 points.

The victory gave Destrehan a 25-2 overall record and 4-1 in District 7-AAA play. Lutchter fell to 3-2 in district play.

While Green was busy scoring and blocking shots, Theron Cojoe was controlling the boards as he pulled down 21 rebounds in the game. The next game for the Wildcats will be Friday night against Ben Franklin at Destrehan.

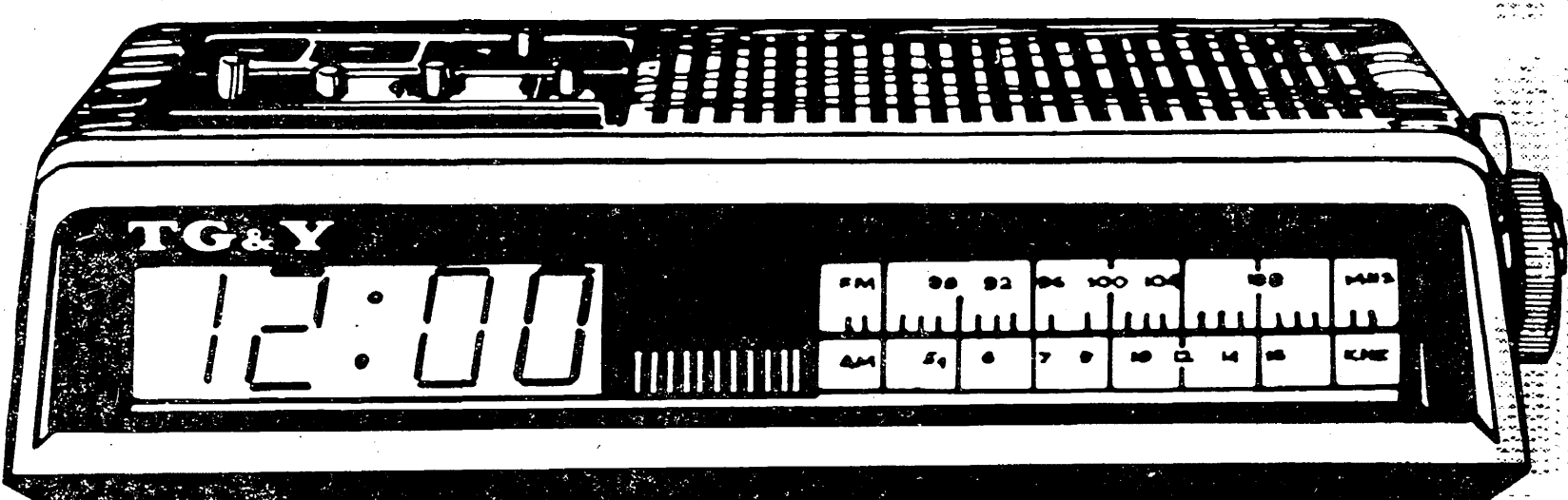
