The Melchior Trophy

Awarded annually to the winning coaches of each division, the Melchior trophies are "traveling" trophies, which remain on display at the schools of the respective division winning coaches for one year. These trophies are awarded in the memory of Brother Melchior Polowy, C.S.C., who has been called the "father" of high school wrestling in Louisiana.

During the early 1940's, Brother Melchior and Mr. William "Cyclone" Schriever introduced interscholastic wrestling to Louisiana. For the following 35 years, Brother Melchior was committed to developing the sport of wrestling throughout the state. For many years he would personally go to competitor schools giving wrestling clinics to the students and their coaches. Frequently he brought his teams to other high schools to demonstrate the art of wrestling to potential competitor wrestlers.

Melchior, the silent mentor, was a man of great dedication and commitment with a unique personal self discipline, goodness, and obedience. Melchior was an incredible teacher by his example. He was the consummate role model for youth and fellow coaches; he was a legend in his own time. His commitment to honesty, loyalty, self respect, and the respect of others on and off the mat was his signpost.

What measure is there of a man once he has departed us? If we were to measure Melchior by his position, rank or title, or by his academic achievements or wealth, there would be challenges, because Melchior was a humble man of worldly poverty. But, if we were to measure him by what he gave from his heart, we could not build a statue large enough to honor him.

These trophies are donated by the Melchior Society, an organization committed to

continuation of the philosophy, ideas, and ideals of Brother Melchior. The objective of the Melchior Society is one of enhancement of ethical performance with emphasis focused on the continuation of a dignified character building approach to the sport of wrestling. Most important is the consideration of dedication, self discipline, team brotherhood, loyalty and humility. It is with great respect for the current and future coaches of Louisiana high school wrestlers that these trophies are awarded in the memory of the spirit of Brother Melchior Polowy, C.S.C.
